Visitors to the Conservatory experience one horticultural environment after another, from the Showcase House with its four yearly seasonal displays; to the lush Tropical House, where orchids and palms thrive in the shadows of a cascading waterfall; to the sparse beauty of the Desert House. The indoor gardens cover 24,500 square feet with over 2,000 plants in the indoor collections representing over 100 plant families, and nearly 1,000 varieties call the Botanical Conservatory home.

### **Garden Etiquette**



- Walkways may be wet. Please use caution.


